



SUMMER READING, WRITING, AND MATH 2017-2018 SCHOOL YEAR, INCOMING GRADE 3

READ 1 BOOK IN EACH OF THE TWO CATEGORIES AND FOLLOW THE DIRECTIONS FOR THE BOOK REPORT. THE BOOK REPORTS, BOOK LOG, AND MATH PACKET ARE DUE ON THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL AND WILL BE GRADED.

1. FICTION BOOK Read a fiction book of your choice. Create a book cover that includes the title, author, and an illustration of the setting of the book. On the back of your cover, write your name and a paragraph of no less than 5 and no more than 7 sentences that describes the setting of the book.

2. NON-FICTION BOOK Read a non-fiction book of your choice. Write a letter to the main character inviting him or her to dinner at your house. Tell the main character why you would like to meet him or her and why you admire that person. Be sure to sign your name to your letter.



BOOK LOG

Each child is encouraged to read beyond the requirements to maintain reading skills throughout the summer. For each additional chapter book read, complete the Book Log form with the title of the book, its author, the date it was read, and a parent signature. The Book Log must be handed in on the first day of school.

WEEKLY SUMMER MATH

Each student must review math during the summer in order to maintain skills and **complete math packet**. **DRILL** the number facts of all the combinations of numbers up through 24. These facts and related fact families must be memorized prior to third grade. Examples include $9+7$, $7+9$, $16-9$, $16-7$. There are many online games that reinforce the facts, and flashcards are a great resource.
